ANTISEMITISM

September 17, 2024

In Argentina, 2023 saw significant spike in antisemitism, with a 44% increase in reported antisemitic incidents in 2023. (Israelnationalnews.com)

September 19, 2024

New survey finds Jewish teens facing a surge in antisemitism from peers and educators in school across the globe with nearly half of survey respondents reporting experiencing antisemitism. Jewish teens stated that 'one of the most disturbing findings' of the survey is the identification of peers as the main perpetrators of antisemitism, with 68.7% of teens pointing to their fellow students as the source of hostility. 'Equally concerning is' the fact that 26.6% of respondents reported facing antisemitism from teachers, and 27.4% from school administrators. (Israelnationalnews.com)

October 1, 2024

Antisemitic attacks, incidents spike around the world in year after October 7. (Jpost.com)

October 11, 2024

Journalists instructed not to acknowledge Jerusalem as part of Israel. CBS News is facing backlash after an internal memo instructed journalists not to refer to Jerusalem as part of Israel. The memo, sent by CBS News senior director of standards Mark Memmoff, emphasized the disputed status of Jerusalem, despite its recognition as Israel's capital by the US government. Memmoff's email advised CBS News staff to avoid saying Jerusalem is in Israel, noting that 'the status of Jerusalem goes to the heart of the Israeli-Palestinian conflict.' Israel considers Jerusalem its 'eternal and undivided' capital while Palestinians claim East Jerusalem—captured by Israel during the 1967 war—as the capital of a future Palestinian state. November 14, 2024

'A disgusting Jew': Uproar after Netflix casts Jewish-Israeli actress to play Mary, Jesus's mom. Netflix released the trailer earlier this week for Mary, its upcoming movie about Jesus's mother—a Jewish woman from the Middle East—and a good chunk of the internet is melting down, because the actress in the lead role is a Jewish woman from the Middle East. Noa Cohen, a 21-year-old Israeli actress, portrays the world's most famous Jewish mom in the movie but some social media users are calling for a boycott. Objections were raised both on the grounds that Cohen is Israeli and that she is Jewish. An X user wrote, 'A disgusting Jew got the part, lol.' (Jpost.com)

November 17, 2024

Rabbi Mazuz calls on Diaspora Jews: 'It is forbidden to live in Europe.' Following the wave of antisemitism in Europe, Rabbi Meir Mazuz called on Jews living in Europe to immigrate to Israel. (Israelnationalnews.com)

November 14, 2024

Following an attack against Israelis in Amsterdam after a soccer game we are reminded that November 9 marked the anniversary of one of history's darkest events: Kristallnacht, the 'Night of Broken Glass,' which signaled the beginning of the Nazi onslaught against Europe's Jews. On November 9-10, 1938, synagogues were torched, Jewish-owned businesses and homes were ransacked, and thousands of jews were sent to concentration camps. Today, the rising tide of antisemitism in the United States and around the world makes us wonder if history is repeating itself. Antisemitic incidents in America, according to the American Defamation League's (ADL's) 2023 audit, have surged to record highs, underscoring an urgent need for action. (Christianpost.com)

European Jewish Association calls on Europe to enact emergency antisemitism policy. Rabbi Menachem Margolin said Europe is in an "antisemitism emergency." "The situation of the Jewish people in Europe today, is the worst it has been since Kristallnacht," he said. He added that the continent was "long past the stage of warnings and prophecies."
